Pre-MOVE

Supporting our students throughout their entire journey is our number one priority.

They will be supported by our dedicated Program Leader (PL) prior to making the move, during and after the Program.

What's important to note here **before** the move:

- The PL will work with the student to create a Candidate Profile and go through detailed interview preparation
- If the student is successful in their application, the PL will help them secure accommodation. If the student is unsuccessful, the PL will be in touch to discuss alternative options.
- Students will have their role in the Whitsundays secured with one of our partners
- Students will have their accommodation secured

Once the student has been successful with a job placement, the best suitable accommodation type will be identified.

Possible accommodation options include:

- Onsite support staff quarters (Daydream Island or Hamilton Island Resort placements) - \$100-\$150/week.
- Airlie Beach (Mainland) - \$220/week.

Important Information

- Students will complete their first semester of the Diploma of Travel and Tourism **prior** to moving to the Whitsundays
- The full duration of the Program is 13 months
- Tailored support available after the Program into further studies, other tourism job across Australia and leadership pathways
- Cost of the Diploma of Travel and Tourism: \$2300/per subject (8 subjects). Fee-Help is available for eligible students.
- Job roles include:
 - Front of house
 - Food and Beverage
 - Guest Services
 - Housekeeping
- Students are treated and paid in accordance with the employer's standards. Our employer partners pay in line with HIGA (Hospitality Industry General Award), plus overtime and weekend penalty rates.
